A Rubberized Cape Seal is a two step process that involves the spreading of small diameter ( $\leq 1/2$ " ) rock with asphalt binder that includes rubber in the emulsion. The rubber holds the rock better than asphalt binder only and also prevents smaller cracks from reflecting through. The second phase is a slurry seal (sand and asphalt binder) applied approximately two weeks later that provides a smooth ride and black finish color.
