UPDATE - PG&E PIPELINE PATHWAYS PROJECT

Dear Property Owner/Resident:

On March 27, 2014, the City sent you a letter providing information regarding the PG&E Pipeline Pathways Project. Since the City's March 27, 2014 letter, the City has continued to work with PG&E and other local jurisdictions in an effort to understand the proposed project and the needs of PG&E and to inform PG&E of the needs and desires of the City and the community relating to same. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the progress made between the City and PG&E and what you can do to continue to protect your rights.

In response to requests by the local jurisdictions, PG&E has agreed to temporarily pause and is internally reviewing the Pathways Project and their approach. This means that PG&E will be discussing the project internally within the company and then communicate with the affected jurisdictions in a few weeks. The City of Martinez has also requested that PG&E return with additional information regarding each and every tree that is proposed to be removed as well as the planned replanting and or replacement landscaping. Once the proposal is submitted to staff, the City will review the proposal and hold a public meeting to review the proposal and receive comment from the adjacent property owners and public at large.

In addition, PG&E has stated that they will honor requests by residents to rescind any agreements that private property owners may have made for work on their private property as part of the Pipeline Pathways Project.
