Outdoor Water Prohibitions

As of June 1st 2015 The following uses of water supplied by the City of Martinez have been determined to be wasteful and are <u>prohibited</u> under the 25 percent State Mandated Drought Management Program:

Single Family and Multi-Family Residential Customers:

- A. Outside watering of landscaping during the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- B. Water more than two days per week.
- C. Outside watering with City furnished water that results in excessive flooding or runoff into a gutter, drain, patio, driveway or street.
- D. Washing a vehicle, trailer or boat with City furnished water using a hose without a shutoff nozzle.
- E. Washing paved or other hard-surfaced areas, including sidewalks, walkways, driveways, patios and parking areas with City furnished water.
- F. Using City furnished water for non-recirculating decorative fountains or filling decorative lakes or ponds.
- G. Watering new home construction landscape except by drip or microspray.

Non-residential Customers:

- A. Outside watering of landscaping during the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- B. Water more than two days per week.
- C. Outside watering with City furnished water that results in excessive flooding or runoff into a gutter, drain, patio, driveway or street.
- D. Washing paved or other hard-surfaced areas, including sidewalks, walkways, driveways, patios and parking areas with City furnished water.
- E. Using City furnished water for non-recirculating decorative fountains or filling decorative lakes or ponds.
- F. Watering new home construction landscape except by drip or microspray
