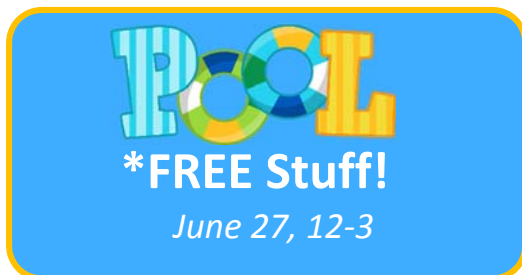

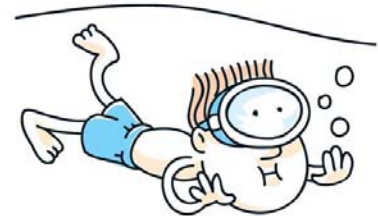

Swim Lesson Tips and Suggestions

- Goggles allow students to swim underwater without eye irritation.
- Please apply sunscreen to your child thirty minutes before class for the best sun protection.
- Girls should pull their hair away from their eyes with a tie or clip. Wet hair falling across the face, mouth, and nose can be frightening for a new swimmer.
- Bring a big fluffy towel to wrap swimmers at the end of class. Even on warm days, the air can feel cold to youngsters exiting the water.
- Please do not hover over the class or sit close to your child's group. The child should be listening to the instructor and following his/her directions.
- Rash guards protect from the sun and the cold.
- Avoid swimmer's ear by removing moisture from the ear as soon as possible.
 - Have the child lay down on the offending side until the water runs out.
 - Blow dry – Put the blow drier on the lowest setting. Blow across—not into the ear.
 - Drugstores sell products specifically for removing water from the ear.

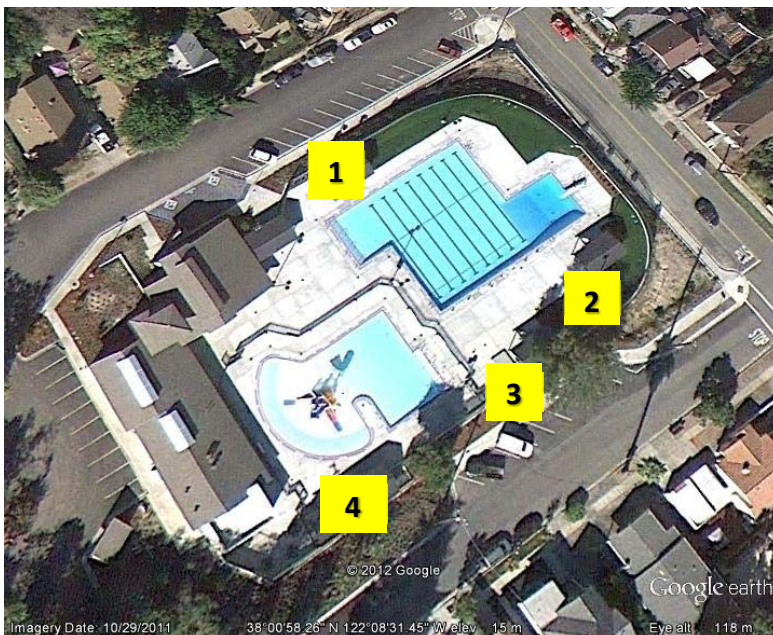

- **ONLY** the Private Pool Party Host(s) may enter the pool area 15 minutes before their scheduled party. Staff needs time to put out safety equipment in the mornings and to clean-up after open swim in the evenings. No one is allowed in the water before the scheduled party time.
- Glass, alcohol, flames, barbecues, confetti and piñatas are not permitted.

Punch Pass Party

Can't afford or don't have enough people to make renting a picnic shelter worthwhile? Purchase a punch pass to cover the price of their admission. Don't want to wait for your friends to arrive? For an additional \$10, the cashiers will hold your passes and check in your guests. No reservations are taken for this program. Purchase your pass at the Admission Booth from the cashier. Bring a complete and legible list of names (first and last) of your party goers. No refund for any unused portions of the pass.

LOCKERS

Lockers are available for day use. Bring your own lock to secure belongings. Any lock left on overnight will be cut off. Items left in the locker will be bagged and placed into Lost and Found. **Rent a Lock for \$5 and upon return receive \$4 back.**

SEASON LOCKER RENTAL

A limited number of lockers are available for rental. The fee is \$15 for the summer. You must bring your own lock. Locks need to be removed by Friday, October 27. Please see a Pool Manager for locker rentals.

LOST, STOLEN & MISSING ITEMS

The City of Martinez is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or missing items. Be sure to check out the "Lost & Found" Bucket by the Pool Office for lost items. Items left in "Lost & Found" for an extended period of time will be washed and donated to charity.

CELL PHONES AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Cell phones, computers, and objects that can be damaged by water should not be in or near the pools. Remember to take phones out of pockets before entering the water. The City of Martinez will not replace or reimburse patrons for items damaged by water.

LIFE JACKETS

We provide free use of life jackets. See a lifeguard to have yourself or your child fitted to the right jacket. Be kind to the life jacket so they may be used by another patron.

Water wings are not allowed. Water wings can easily slip off a child. These inexpensive inflatable toys do not prevent drowning, nor do they take the place of a Coast Guard approved life jacket or *vest. Water wings do not help children learn proper swimming technique. They put the child in a vertical floating position instead of the horizontal, the basis for learning any swim stroke. *Vests or lifejackets brought from home must be Coast Guard approved to be used.



Has your child grown out of a life jacket or puddle jumper? Donate it to the Rankin Aquatic Center where it will be used daily by non-swimmers and we will give you one admission free as our thanks.

JUNIOR LIFEGUARD PROGRAM

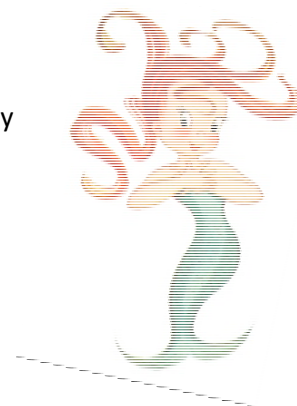
