

POLICE BLOTTER FOR SEPT. 1-15, 2017



9/1-9/5

- Officer Buda responded to the 1200 block of Morello Avenue for a stolen vehicle report. The 1996 Ford F350 was stolen sometime overnight.
- Officer Carney responded to a business on Howe Road for a stolen vehicle report. An employee's 1996 Honda Accord was stolen between 6:00 am and 12:00 pm. It was later recovered in El Cerrito.
- Officer Breinig contacted a male subject in the 1800 block of Estudillo Street. The subject had a misdemeanor warrant for his arrest. He was arrested and booked into the Main Detention Facility (MDF).
- Sergeant Busciglio contacted a known male subject at Valley Convenient Mart. The male was arrested for a felony warrant and being in possession of a controlled substance. He was booked into MDF.
