On February 21, 2018, at 7:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers located at 525 Henrietta Street in Martinez, the City of Martinez City Council will conduct the fifth Public Hearing regarding establishing single-member council districts in which to conduct by-district elections for the City Council members, and the potential sequence of elections in such districts. The public is invited to provide input at this hearing regarding the content of the draft map or maps establishing the boundaries of each City Council district and the proposed sequence of elections. At the sixth and final public hearing on February 28, 2018, the City Council will conduct a final vote to approve or defeat an ordinance establishing district-based elections and, if such an ordinance is adopted, establishing the boundaries of each City Council district and sequence of elections in such districts.
