Lifeguard Certification (with Title 22)



All candidates must be 15 years old before the date of the last class and pass a swimming and pretest to qualify for the class. The swimming pretest will take place the first day of the class. Participants **MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM 300 YARDS WITHOUT STOPPING**, retrieve a 10 lb. brick from the bottom of a 10-foot pool. If you fail, the test you will not be allowed to continue the course and will be refunded all but \$50. Participants **MUST** attend all classes/ skill trainings and successfully complete three written tests to become certified. There are no make-ups for missed classes. Classes are held at the Rankin Aquatic Swim Center, 100 Buckley Street. \$35 American Red Cross Certification Fee included. Go to www.cityofmartinez to register online.

Free Magic Show

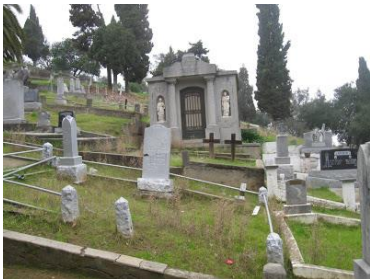
