

POLICE BLOTTER FOR JUNE 1-15, 2018



On June 1st at 11:00 am, officers were dispatched to Home Depot for a possible theft. Sergeant Gaul located the suspect vehicle on Morello Avenue at SR-4. He contacted the man from Vallejo. He was found to be in possession of numerous credit cards and ID's. One confirmed stolen at this time. He was also arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia. He was cite released. Case# 18-1264.
