**Subject: Waterfront Park Ribbon Cutting Ceremony**

MARTINEZ – The City is pleased to announce the Waterfront Park Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will be held at the ballfields entrance off Joe DiMaggio Drive at 6 p.m. on Thursday, October 25. This cornerstone project funded primarily through Measure H reconstructed and renovated the entire Waterfront Park area. Work included new field lighting and fencing, a new group picnic area, various smaller picnic areas, a restroom at the tot lot, a new parking lot and repaving of existing parking lot at the bocce courts, repaving of the north parking lot, new trails and sidewalks, new safety lighting and expansion of the events meadow.

The project is complete and the contractor's landscape maintenance period has ended. Field 3 was completed on May 30, 2018 in time to host the Martinez Clippers' professional baseball season. The remainder of Waterfront Park was opened on September 28<sup>th</sup>, at which time fields 1, 2 and 4 were opened for softball play.
