

POLICE BLOTTER FOR OCT.16-31, 2018



On October 16th at 8:11 am officers responded to the Family Law Center due to a bomb threat phoned in by an unknown female. The building was closed and searched. No explosive device was located, and the threat was deemed not credible. This investigation is continuing. Case# 18-2448.
