

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR DEC. 16-31, 2018



On December 16<sup>th</sup> at 1:04 am, Lieutenant Gaul was on patrol in the 3800 block of Vista Oaks Drive when he contacted a 30-year-old man from Martinez, who he knows from prior police contacts.
