***Contra Costa County Public Works to Close a Section of Marina Vista Street in Martinez Due to Construction of the New Administrative Building***

**April 9, 2019, Martinez, CA** – Contra Costa County Public Works will close a section of Marina Vista Street on **Wednesday, April 17<sup>th</sup>** for the placement of the off-site sanitary sewer for the new County Administration building. Traffic control measures and traffic rerouting will be implemented starting on April 17<sup>th</sup> and continue through April 26<sup>th</sup>.

The street will be closed starting at approximately 8 A.M. on Wednesday, April 17<sup>th</sup> and will re-open by 5 P.M. on Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
