

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR MAY 16-31, 2019



On May 16<sup>th</sup> at 6:27 am, officers responded to 1836 Alhambra Ave. (Vintage Market) for a report of a man breaking down the fence leading to the rear of the building. Officers contacted the 24-year-old resident of Antioch and arrested him for felony vandalism. He was booked into the Martinez Detention Facility (MDF). Case # 19-1371 by Officer Wah.
