**Subject: PARK IMPROVEMENTS DESIGN CHARRETTE – Future Public Park -  
Traditions at the Meadow (formerly Pine Meadow)**

MARTINEZ – **On Saturday, August 10, 2019 at noon in the City Hall Council Chambers located at 525 Henrietta Street**, the Parks, Recreation, Marina and Cultural Commission (PRMCC) will hold a design charrette relating to potential park improvements for a public park to be located on a portion of the former Pine Meadow Golf Course site.

*Background:* On July 17, 2019, the City approved a Final Map for the Traditions at the Meadow (formerly, Pine Meadows), project to be located on the former Pine Meadows Golf Course Property. The final map reduces the development footprint of the residential portion of the property and sets forth an approximately 9 acre portion of the former golf course as a public park, to be deeded to either the City or another appropriate entity. Denova Homes will provide and pay for \$1,000,000 of improvements on the park area and associated open space and pedestrian paths. The City is conducting a public process to determine the public improvements to be constructed in this new park. The first step in this design process will be a design charrette before the PRMCC. The charrette will help to inform the proposed park improvement design which will subsequently be presented to the PRMCC for a formal recommendation. Consideration of the recommendation and final approval of the park improvements will be considered by the City Council at a subsequent public meeting.

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The public is invited to participate in the charrette to form a vision with ideas for improvements proposed to be constructed in the new park. The PRMCC will be reviewing a design and making a recommendation to the City Council at their regularly scheduled meeting of August 20, 2019 at 7 PM.

In addition, the design is anticipated to be considered for recommendation at the Planning Commission meeting on August 27, 2019.

The City Council is anticipated to consider the park design at their regular meeting on September 18, 2019.

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
