## WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

### KNOW THE LAW

<i>Activity</i>	<i>Previous Penalty</i>	<i>New Penalty Under PROP 64</i>
<b>Possession up to 1 ounce of marijuana</b>	Infraction- \$100 ticket	Legal for 21+ for personal non-commercial use
<b>Possession over 1 ounce of marijuana</b>	Misdemeanor- six months, \$500	Misdemeanor- six months, \$500
<b>Intent to sell</b>	Felony- 16 months/ two/three years	Misdemeanor- six months, \$500
<b>Sales to minors</b>	Felony- 3-7 years	Felony- 3-7 years
<b>Possession up to 8 grams concentrate</b>	Misdemeanor- 1 year, \$500 or both	Legal for 21+ for personal non-commercial use
<b>Possession over 8 grams concentrate</b>	Misdemeanor- one year, \$500	Misdemeanor- six months, \$500
<b>Transport up to one ounce</b>	Misdemeanor- \$100	Legal for 21+ for personal non-commercial use
<b>Transport/ Give away over one ounce</b>	Felony- two/three/four years	Misdemeanor- six months, \$500
<b>Give away up to one ounce</b>	Misdemeanor- \$100	Legal for 21+ for personal non-commercial use
<b>Homegrow up to six plants per residence</b>	Felony- 16 months, two/three years	Legal for 21+ for personal non-commercial use
<b>Homegrow over six plants</b>	Felony- 16 months, two/ three years	Misdemeanor- six months, \$500
<b>Smoking where tobacco is banned</b>	\$100 ticket	\$250 ticket

### KNOW THE HAZARDS AND COMPLY WITH ALL CITY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDOOR CULTIVATION

**Electrical modifications risk fires.**

- Indoor grow lights cannot exceed 1,000 watts per light fixture. Generally, existing electrical circuitry cannot accommodate additional lighting loads of this size.
- The use of extension cords should be avoided.
- A portable fire extinguisher must be kept in the same room where cultivation is occurring.
- Gas products for cultivations or processing are prohibited.

**Overloaded circuits can leave entire neighborhoods in the dark.**

**Poor irrigation can cause mold.**

- Avoid disconnecting furnace venting, or holes in floors and walls for increased airflow.

**Plant chemicals can cause illness.**

**Improper carbon dioxide mixed with insufficient ventilation can cause death.**

- Appropriate ventilation and filtration systems must be installed.

**Structural changes put first responders in danger as they rush into the unknown.**

The structure where the cultivation is occurring shall fully comply with the California Building Codes and applicable sections of the city's building and construction codes. These conditions are aimed at minimizing the adverse effects of indoor marijuana grows that come from the incorrect installation of grow lights, ventilation and humidity systems used to cultivate marijuana.
