

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR MARCH 1-15, 2020



On March 1<sup>st</sup> at 2:49 am, Officer Lucido conducted a pedestrian stop during his downtown patrol. He contacted a 27-year-old man from Martinez, who subsequently had an outstanding warrant. During a search, Officer Lucido located a small amount of methamphetamine. Officer Lucido booked the man into MDF on the warrant and 11377 HS (possession of controlled substance). Case# 20-515.
