

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR FEB. 16-29, 2020



On February 16<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 pm, Officer Wah responded to the Skate Park bathroom. A suspect had ignited the toilet paper dispenser and caused minor damage. Upon reviewing security camera footage, there's possible suspects. Corp Yard notified. Case# 20-394.

Officer Montano responded to the area of Glacier Drive at Sequoia Drive for a vehicle collision. Upon her arrival, she contacted the driver, who was driving a black Toyota Camry (#7KXL721) S/B on Glacier Drive when he collided with a parked vehicle. The vehicle he collided with was pushed onto another parked vehicle, which in turn collided with a fire hydrant. During Officer Montano's investigation, she concluded the driver was operating the vehicle under the influence of alcohol. The driver was arrested for CVC 23152 A/ B and transported to MPD.

A search of the vehicle per the man's parole terms, identified several pieces of "Leica" surveying equipment. There was no personal identifying information on the equipment and an ARIES search for stolen property did not reveal a match. The vehicle was towed from the scene per CVC 22651(o). The man was released from the scene. Corporal Breinig followed-up with the surveying equipment to a possible match to a Caltrans vehicle on Thistle Way. Case# 20-454.
