

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR MAY 16-31, 2020



On May 16th at 12:19 am, Officer Parsons responded to the 1000 block of Palisade Dr. for a stolen car report. The victim reported his white 2008 Nissan Versa Ca Lic# 6EQB393 had been stolen between 6:00 pm and the time of call. Case# 20-1053.

The suspect failed to follow instructions by Officer Parsons and ultimately resisted being arrested for public intoxication as well as violation of probation. The suspect was ultimately arrested where he continued to behave erratically. Once in the rear of a patrol vehicle, he attempted kicking the passenger side rear window of Officer Parsons' patrol vehicle. Fearing for the suspect's safety and attempting to prevent further destruction of city property, the suspect was placed in a WRAP restraint device and later transported to MDF where he was booked for 647(f) PC and 1203.32 PC. The day shift dispatcher held over to graves to assist with calls for service.

At 9:44 pm, officers responded to an alarm call at Velvet located at 4808 Sunrise Drive. Three subjects were seen on the video alarm running toward the building wearing masks and hoodies. An exterior check was made and the building was secure. At 10:22 pm, the alarm company called back and advised they now had a glass break activation. The alarm company advised there were people inside and rummaging through the store. Officers arrived and found the front door was smashed. Entry was made and a safe, cash and product was taken. A review of the video showed approximately 20 subjects returned to the business and rushed inside to take the listed loss. Investigation is ongoing by Corporal Mayberry. Case# 20-1176.
