

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR JUNE 16-31, 2020



On June 16th at 3:52 pm, Officer Angoco responded to the 6600 block of Alhambra Avenue for a male passed out in a vehicle. The male was arrested for possession of a controlled substance. Case 20-1307.
