Thank you for your interest in serving on the City of Martinez Task Force on Anti-Racism and Discrimination and Pro Inclusion and Equity (ARDPIE). The City Council receives advice and assistance from various Council appointed Commissions, Committees, and Task Forces made up of residents of Martinez and/or individuals with expertise in a particular area. Task forces address specific issues that have been formally recognized by the City Council. Any responsibility or authority they have is given to them by the City Council.

The Task Force on Anti-Racism and Discrimination and Pro Inclusion and Equity will be comprised of nine members appointed by the City Council. The Task Force will be selected based on geographic diversity, age diversity, ethnic diversity, and advocacy diversity. The selection process needs to include the recommendations of a City Manager-selected community panel. Criteria for appointment and duties of commission and committee members are defined in the Martinez Municipal Code and/or by-laws of the committee.

Task Force members will play a key role addressing the ongoing calls for racial justice at the national, state and local levels. The initial work plan of the Task Force would include three phases.

- Phase I: Host single or multiple community conversations regarding racism and discrimination.
- Phase II: Review the City's policies, procedures, and programming to eliminate racism and discrimination and advance racial equity and social justice.
- Phase III: Develop a recommendation to the City Council on process improvements that can be made to eliminate racism and discrimination and further promote Equity and Inclusion.

The Task Force will meet regularly as scheduled by the members, until recommendations have been developed to propose to the City Council.

The deadline for submitting an application for consideration is September 1, 2020. For more information about the establishment of the Task Force on Anti-Racism and Discrimination and Pro Inclusion and Equity, please refer to the staff report [here](#).

It is the policy of the City Council to make appointments to the citizen commissions, boards, committees, and task forces based on the needs of the city, as well as the interests and qualifications of each applicant. Selection will be made without discrimination based on the race, creed, gender, or sexual orientation of the applicant.
