

POLICE BLOTTER FOR AUG. 1-15, 2020



On August 1st at 1:46 am, Officers Murray and Green responded to the John Muir Inn at 445 Muir Station Road regarding subjects who had previously been advised by officers to return to their room as they were disturbing other guests. Upon arrival Officer Murray contacted one of the subjects he had previously observed consuming alcoholic beverages in the stairwell with another subject. Upon contact one subject attempted to flee up the stairs and into a common area. Both subjects were ultimately contacted and in possession of opened as well as unopened alcoholic beverages.
