

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR AUG. 19-31, 2020



On August 16th at 12:31 pm, Officer Buda was dispatched to 7-Eleven, 530 Morello Ave., for a man passed out behind the wheel at the pumps. He contacted the man, who had an outstanding felony no-bail warrant for his arrest, as well as probation with terms for search. A search of the vehicle revealed codeine syrup with the owner's name scratched off the label, and fentanyl. He was booked into MDF. Case# 20-1748.

The group did leave and that solved the problem, but they clearly challenged the officers. Case# 20-1796.
