Due to COVID-19 safety guidelines, the Martinez Senior Center remains closed to the public, and therefore the Drop Box previously provided inside the facility will not be available for this election cycle. Please refer to the locations listed above.

Under [Executive Order N-64-20](#) and [Assembly Bill 860](#), *all registered voters will be mailed a Vote-by-Mail ballot* for the November 3, 2020 Election, with first class postage pre-paid.

These ballots will still be counted if received up to 17 days after Election Day, if postmarked by Election Day, November 3, 2020. Thus, the Contra Costa County Elections Division and the [CDC encourages you to Vote-by-Mail](#).
