

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR NOV. 1-15, 2020



On November 1<sup>st</sup> at 1:32 am, Officer Murray conducted an enforcement stop in the area of Howe Road and Pacheco Boulevard. He contacted the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, a 61-year-old man from Pacheco, who admitted to ingesting methamphetamine. The man consented to a search of his person, which yielded a usable amount of methamphetamine. He was placed under arrest for the H&S violation and cite released at the scene. Case# 20-2321.

As officers arrived, they located a 21-year-old male who had sustained a non-life-threatening gunshot wound to his lower extremity. He was treated by paramedics and subsequently transported to a local hospital.

While investigating the shooting, Martinez Police Department's dispatch center received a call from a local hospital regarding three other male subjects; ages 25, 24 and 17. They all arrived at the hospital with stab wounds, later determined to have occurred during the same shooting incident. Officers responded to the hospital to investigate the stabbing. All three subjects suffered minor to moderate injuries and are expected to survive. There are no outstanding suspects at this time. Based on the investigation it appears that this was not a random event and all parties involved have been identified.
