

POLICE BLOTTER FOR DEC. 1-15, 2020



On December 1st at 11:29 pm, Officer Williamson conducted an enforcement stop on a U-Haul truck that had run several stop signs in front of him. He was able to stop the truck at the intersection of Shell @ Monterey Avenue. He contacted the driver and learned he was on CDCR parole for burglary. Officer Williamson conducted a parole search and located burglary tools and Xanax pills. He arrested the driver and released him at the scene. This case will be forwarded to the CCC DA's Office for review and disposition. Case# 20-2548.

On December 2nd at 12:12 am, Officer Ramos conducted a suspicious vehicle check in the marina. He contacted a male subject, known to him from prior contacts. He developed probable cause and ultimately searched the vehicle. Officer Ramos located and seized approx. 31 grams of methamphetamines. He arrested the suspect and released him at the scene. The subject continued to demand Officer Mayberry shoot him and walked back to his vehicle and opened the door. Officer Mayberry was concerned the subject may have or retrieve a weapon from the vehicle, so he deployed his Taser. The subject was detained without further incident. No weapons were located and he was transported. No crime occurred on Smith Drive. Case# 20-2614.

On December 10th at 4:20 pm, officers responded to the Nob Hill CVS for a subject inside who was possibly stealing items and placed a syringe in the garbage. Officers contacted the male subject who was from Oakley. He was arrested for possession of meth and cite-released from the scene. No theft occurred at this time. Case# 20-2617.

The victim fled the house and heard the male subject fire a third shot. The male subject was the only occupant in the residence and several attempts were made to call him. Lieutenants Salamid and Estanol arrived on scene to assist with the perimeter/arrest.
