



POLICE BLOTTER FOR JAN. 1-15, 2021

On January 1st at 1:50 am, Sergeant Lekse conducted a pedestrian stop on two people at the Muir Lodge Motel, 3930 Alhambra Avenue. After determining one subject was on probation and ascertaining what room the two people were associated with, the investigation was continued by both Officer Clark and Officer Hall. A 43-year-old man from Pleasant Hill was arrested by Officer Clark for being in possession of both methamphetamine and heroin. A 42-year-old woman from Martinez was arrested by Officer Hall for possession of methamphetamine for sales. Both people were released at the scene. Officer Clark/Officer Hall, case# 21-2.

On January 1st at 7:15 am, Officer Mayberry discovered the front window smashed to Lipary's Collectibles on Main Street. The owner responded at a later time and reviewed surveillance footage. It was determined the incident occurred at 5:30 am. A lone subject on an endure type motorcycle could be seen pulling up to the window. The subject fastens an item to the window, which was most likely a small M-80 or M-100 type of firework. The subject leaves and the item detonates. The window remained intact, however it shattered and there was a hole approximately the size of a grapefruit. Officer Mayberry was able to zoom in on the license plate and learned the motorcycle had been reported stolen to Pleasant Hill PD on December 29th. Officer Mayberry was able to locate some evidence and will send it to the lab for DNA evidence. This case is still under investigation. Case# 21-3.

On January 1st at 8:30 am, Officer Murray contacted several subjects at the intersection of Pine Street and Shell Avenue. A male and female were contacted. The male had a warrant for his arrest and also found to be in possession of methamphetamine. The female also possessed a small amount of methamphetamine. Both subjects were arrested and cite-released from the scene. Case# 21-4.

On January 1st at 4:00 pm, Officer Murray was dispatched to Safeway for a theft that just occurred. As Officer Murray arrived, he located the subject who then fled. The motorcycle was registered out of Ohio but stolen in Antioch in July of 2020. A subject attempted to leave on the motorcycle and was contacted. The subject was known to Martinez PD as a local car thief. He claimed he bought the motorcycle, but had no associated paperwork. During a probation search, Sergeant Busciglio located 7.8 grams of methamphetamine. He was arrested and cite-released from the scene. The motorcycle was towed to be returned to the legal owner. On January 5th at 10:07 pm, the entire graveyard shift was dispatched to the 700 block of Vine Hill Way for a subject found in the victim's home as they slept. Initially the subject told them he had been accosted by two men and then pistol whipped while at Nancy Boyd Park. During further investigation, and after reviewing recent surveillance over other crimes, it was determined the subject fabricated the story and was actually in the process of burglarizing the victim's home. He was also the responsible for another burglary and car theft in the Westaire neighborhood the prior night. Attempts were made to book the juvenile into Juvenile Hall, however they would not accept the booking as this was not a "violent crime." The minor was arrested and then released to his father. The above associated reports will be sent to the DA's Office for review and disposition. Case# 21-36.

On January 6th at 11:42 pm, Officer Ramos conducted an enforcement stop in the area of 4041 Alhambra Avenue and contacted a person known to MPD. Officer Ramos requested assistance from K9 Officer Lincoln, due to his K9 partner being certified in narcotics detection. During a K9 search, K9 Jago located 9.1 grams of methamphetamine.
