

POLICE BLOTTER FOR JAN. 16-31, 2021



On January 16th at 1:04 am, officers responded to the 4200 block of Alhambra Way on a report of a male sleeping in a running vehicle. They contacted the solo male occupant, and after some observations of the male, began a DUI investigation. He was ultimately arrested for DUI alcohol. Case# 21-115.

On January 16th at 11:15 am, Officer Mayberry was dispatched to the 800 block of Shell Ave. for a vehicle theft. Sometime during the evening, an unknown suspect took a 2001 Chevy Silverado from the front of the victim's home. Case# 21-117.
