

POLICE BLOTTER FOR MAR. 1-15, 2021



On March 1st at 8:08 am, officers were dispatched to the 3900 block of Canyon Way regarding a theft of a catalytic converter. The theft occurred sometime during the evening hours from 2/27-2/28. The victim vehicle is a 2008 Toyota Prius. Case# 21-473.

On March 1st at 9:31 am, officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Arnold Drive regarding a subject trying to gain entry into a locked laundry room. Officers detained a male in the immediate area and determined he had not illegally entered the laundry room. However, the male was arrested and cite-released from the scene for possession of burglary tools. Case# 21-476.

On March 2nd at 5:07 am, officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Bush Street for a suspicious vehicle that was parked. The vehicle may have been involved in recent catalytic converter thefts. Sergeant Brinser located the vehicle, which immediately fled. Sergeant Brinser did not pursue the vehicle. He located a 2001 Toyota Prius in the area which had its converter removed. The suspects were described as two males wearing facemasks and hoodies. As officers were responding, the suspects were able to gain access to the pharmacy and forced several employees into the secure area of the pharmacy. With the assistance of the Pleasant Hill Police Department, the store was surrounded. As officers began evacuating nearby businesses, the suspects attempted to flee and were immediately apprehended. Both suspects were determined to be juveniles, 17 and 15 years old, from the Solano County area. No one was physically injured during the incident. They were booked into Contra Costa County Juvenile Hall on the following charges: Robbery, Kidnapping, Kidnapping to Commit a Theft and Criminal Threats. Detectives from the Martinez Police Department are actively working this case. Case# 21-548.

On March 10th at 2:05 pm, officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Richardson Street for an unresponsive male in a group care home. Life-saving measures were attempted by medical personnel; however, the 57-year-old male could not be resuscitated. Case# 21-549.

On March 10th at 11:50 pm, Officer Green conducted an enforcement stop on Berrellesa at Marina Vista. He contacted the driver and conducted a consent search. The search revealed a small amount of Fentanyl. She was arrested and cite-released from the scene. Case# 21-557.

The victim was able to detain the suspect on the ground until MPD units arrived. The suspect was arrested and booked into county jail on the charges of grand theft.
