

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR MAR. 16-31, 2021



On March 17th at 10:03 am, Officer Clark conducted an enforcement stop in the parking lot of 1185 Arnold Drive. He contacted the driver and determined he was driving on a suspended license. He arrested and cite-released the driver. Case# 21-613.

On March 17th at 9:43 pm, Officer Green conducted an enforcement stop in the 1000 block of Arnold Drive. He determined the driver had an outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrant. A search incident to the arrest revealed a small amount of methamphetamine. The driver was arrested and cite-released for the drug possession and provided a new court date for the warrant. Case# 21-619.

On March 18th at 12:58 am, officers were dispatched to the 700 block of Ferry Street for a physical fight between two males. It was determined only a verbal argument occurred. One of the subjects was in violation of 647(f)PC - Public Intoxication and arrested. Case# 21-620.

On March 18th at 1:45 pm, officers were dispatched to 7-11 on Alhambra Avenue for a female subject who was panhandling. Officer Hall located the female and made contact with her. During a records check, he learned the female had three felony and two misdemeanor warrants for her arrest. The listed charges were for vehicle theft, felony evading, burglary and other property crimes. During the booking process, county jail refused her to be booked based on an injury she sustained prior to MPD contacting her. She was cite-released from the jail and provided new court dates. On Mar 20th at 2:35 am, officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Estudillo Street on an alarm activation. The caller told the officers he observed a subject in a rain jacket on the property through surveillance footage. As officers arrived, they located an open door on the Green Street side, as well as a broken window. They conducted an interior check and located a male inside. The male was arrested without incident. Officers determined the male also damaged and gained entry into two vehicles also on the property. County jail initially denied the subject. Officer Angoco transported him to the hospital and had him medically cleared for booking. Officer Angoco then booked him into county jail. Case# 21-628.

On March 20th at 8:13 pm, Officer Murray conducted an enforcement stop in the 100 block of Muir Road. He contacted the driver and conducted a vehicle search. The search revealed a small amount of cocaine and paraphernalia. He arrested and cite-released the driver from the scene. Case# 21-631.

No one was injured during the robbery. The amount taken is still being tabulated. The suspect left his note. Both the note and countertop were processed for potential fingerprint/DNA evidence. This case is being handled by MPD investigations.

On March 22nd at 9:57 pm, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Buckley Street for a vehicle parked in the middle of the roadway and was still running. Officers contacted a subject in the driver's seat. The subject was arrested for several narcotics charges, as well as violating probation. The suspect was processed at the PD and cite-released. On March 23rd at 2:42 am, officers were dispatched to the 500 block of Glacier Drive for two subjects running from security. MPD was never notified of the alarm prior. The subjects gained entry into two classrooms and possibly stole 10 Chromebooks. Loss is still being tabulated. Case# 21-652.
