

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR APR. 1-15, 2021



On April 1st at 1:30 pm, a subject came to the station to inquire if he was "wanted". A records check revealed the subject had an outstanding felony arrest warrant for assault with a deadly weapon. The subject was arrested and booked into county jail without incident. Case# 21-722.

On April 1st at 2:20 pm, officers responded to Walmart for a theft suspect who was causing a disturbance with loss prevention. They contacted the subject and were able to gain control and arrest her without incident. She was cite-released at the scene. Case# 21-723.

On April 2nd at 11:00 am, officers were dispatched to the 2300 block of Pinnacle Dr. for a man who discovered his elderly mother had passed away. Case# 21-729.

The subject was transported to the PD, processed and released to a responsible adult. The vehicle was towed incident to the arrest. During the argument, the suspect produced a pistol and fired several shots. The victim was transported. The suspect was booked into county jail on the charges of assault with a deadly weapon. This is still an active investigation and MPD Detectives will be conducting further interviews. Case# 21-799.

Officer Hoyles located the suspect, a 34-year-old man from Bay Point, and determined the man was under the influence of alcohol, in violation of 647(f)PC. He was arrested and booked into MDF.
