



POLICE BLOTTER FOR JUNE 1-15, 2021

On June 1st at 10:26 am, officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Mill Road to investigate an auto theft. Sometime during the evening, an unknown suspect stole the white 1994 Acura Integra from the driveway. Case# 21-1153.

On June 1st at 2:43 pm, officers were dispatched to the 600 block of Skyline Drive to investigate an auto theft. Sometime during the evening, an unknown suspect stole a black 2001 Harley Davidson from the driveway. Case# 21-1155.
