

POLICE BLOTTER FOR JULY 1-15, 2021



On July 2nd at 2:35 pm, officers were dispatched to the area of Morello Avenue and Brittany Hills Drive for a female walking in a torn dress with parts of her private areas showing. Sergeant Brinser located the female in the area. He determined she had not been assaulted. She however had three outstanding misdemeanor warrants for her arrest. She was cite-released from the scene and provided a courtesy ride to her mother's home. Case# 21-1392.

On July 2nd at 7:10 pm, officers responded to Walmart for subjects being detained on suspicion of theft. Officers arrived and determined one of the subjects had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. She was arrested and cite-released from the scene. Case# 21-1394.

On July 4th at 1:34 am, an unknown suspect set fire to two dumpsters behind Petco on Arnold Drive. The fires were extinguished and no structures were affected. Case# 21-1401.

The male was located in an outside patio naked. He screamed at the officers to "Kill Me!!". They were able to detain the subject and had to utilize a WRAP as the subject continued to kick at them. Upon arrival, officers contacted the 29-year-old man from Bay Point. A wants/warrants check was conducted and it revealed a misdemeanor warrant for the man. At 10:10 pm, officers responded to 1200 Morello Park Drive for a vehicle stuck on the median near the school. Upon arrival, officers contacted the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, a 69-year-old woman from Pittsburg. As a result of initial observations, a DUI investigation was initiated. At the completion, the woman was placed under arrest for VC 23152 (A) & (B). She was transported to the police station for collection of blood evidence. After blood evidence was collected, she was released to the custody of a family member. Officer Bui, case# 21-1449.

At 2:08 am, officers responded to the area of Alhambra Avenue @ McMahon Court for a vehicle that was involved in a misdemeanor hit & run. Both the suspect's vehicle and the victim's vehicle were located on E/B Sr4 Pine Street off-ramp. Investigation revealed the collision occurred on Main Street between Arlington Way and Talbart Street. The suspect collided with the victim and fled the scene. The victim followed the vehicle and called police for the assistance. The suspect was identified as a 47-year-old woman

from Concord. Upon contact, it was determined she displayed symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. Due to her agitated and uncooperative behavior, SFST's were not able to be conducted. She was placed under arrest for VC 20002 and VC 23152(A) and transported to the police station for blood evidence collection. A DUI blood warrant was authored by Officer Weems and authorized by the on-call judge. After the collection of blood evidence, she was transported and booked into MDF. Officer Weems, case# 21-1451.
