

POLICE BLOTTER FOR JULY 16-31, 2021



On July 15th at 7:45 am, officers responded to 205 Vista Way, John Muir Elementary, on a report of a burglary that occurred overnight. The caller stated an unknown suspect threw rocks at windows, gaining access to class rooms. The caller stated they were never notified of the activation. There was not an apparent loss. Case# 21-1493.

At 3:59 pm, a victim in the 900 block of Morello Avenue reported the theft of a catalytic converter from a box truck. Case# 21-1498.

At 5:15 pm, officers arrived in 1000 block of Rolling Hill Way on a report of a suspicious vehicle. The caller called the police due to their neighbors being out of town. As officers arrived, two subjects ran and jumped into another vehicle and fled the area. The other two subjects walked away. One of the associated vehicles had been involved in a pursuit with San Pablo PD earlier, as well as a theft from Safeway stores in Martinez. All four subjects were located and detained. San Pablo PD arrived and took custody of the driver who was involved in the earlier pursuit. The other three (juveniles) were released at the scene with complaint(s) to follow. The merchandise was recovered and returned to Safeway. The property had an estimated value of \$1000.00. Case# 21-1499.

At 10:30 pm, officers contacted a man at Alhambra Avenue and B Street. The man was known to have outstanding warrants. He was detained and arrested without incident. He was cite released at the scene. Case# 21-1501.
