

## POLICE BLOTTER FOR AUGUST 1-15, 2021



On August 1st at 2:02 am, Officer Bui conducted an enforcement stop at Pacheco Boulevard and Blum Road. He contacted the driver who exhibited signs of alcohol impairment. FST's were conducted and the driver was arrested for DUI. He was then booked into county jail after a blood sample was obtained. Case# 21-1605.
