Someone needs social servicesCORE at 211

Social Services include basic food and hygiene, access to shelter, bed, medical, mental health, etc. You can also email CORE@cchealth.org.

IMMEDIATE THREAT to life/property, medical emergency: **911**

OTHER ACTIVITIES incl. refusing to leave or creating a disturbance: **925-372-3440**

Illegal activities include loitering, prowling, fighting, trespassing, aggressive panhandling, indecent exposure, behaving in a threatening manner and more. CORE should not be called for these activities.



TIPS AND RESOURCES

- ✓ Trim landscaping to eliminate hiding places.
- ✗ Don't allow anyone to store shopping carts, bedding, or personal items on your property.
- ✗ Don't allow camping or loitering on your property.
- ✓ Avoid confrontations!
